

# Research Study: Survey on Accessibility in Canada

We are a research team from KITE, the research arm of Toronto Rehabilitation University Health Network. We want to learn about the main barriers to accessibility that individuals in Canada experience.

Who is invited to participate:

Individuals who are 18 years old or older, live in Canada, and identify as at least one of the following:

- A person with a disability
- An older adults, 65 years old or older, who do not have a disability
- A (formal or informal) caregiver for a person with a disability

About one-time survey:

- 20 to 27 questions
- Three ways to take part: online, paper version (in 12 pt. or 16 pt. sized font) sent by mail, or telephone interview.
- Participants can enter a draw for a \$40 gift card. One card will be awarded to every 10 participants.
